

HOSPITAL LIES – PERFORMANCE DETAILS

STAGE CURTAIN

- We will set up a 10' x 25' curtain that obscures the stage during our setup and teardown. A steel cable will be installed pre-show and will remain for the duration of the event.
- We can use existing mounting and rigging hardware/connections if the venue has these installed, but we also have a variety of bolts, hooks, and straps to affix the curtain cable depending on the venue's preferences and restrictions.
- The curtain bares our "HL" logo, but may be used by other bands/artists during the event

SET UP/TEAR DOWN MUSIC

- We request that specific songs of our choosing be played during our setup and teardown. This music is not part of our set time but is intended to create the desired atmosphere.

BAND AND CREW – 7 TOTAL

- Band Members: 3 Musicians
- Stage Performer ("Doctor"): 1 Performer
- Stagehand: Assists with setup/teardown and curtain operation. Additional stagehands used as needed.
- Videographer: Alternates between onstage and in-crowd filming
- Merch Booth Attendant: Manages merchandise sales

STAGE LIGHTING

- 2 8' steel light fixture poles and 10+ additional light fixtures will be set up around the venue and on stage for the event. We will have our own rigging and stands for these but may need to use venue truss systems as well. Any house UV and/or neon lighting is encouraged to be active if the venue has these accommodations.

STAGE FOG

- We use a prop fog machine at the start of our set, activated and maneuvered by a stage performer who performs a theatrical act involving a mock "sedation" of the crowd.
- The fog machine uses a water-based cotton candy scent additive, similar to those used in haunted houses and 4DX movie theatres.
- The prop fog machine will be used for approximately 2 minutes during our intro. We will need additional house fog for the rest of our set if possible.

ADDITIONAL PERFORMANCE INFORMATION

- During one song, a stage performer will inhale Vitamin B powder (aka "stage cocaine") in a theatrical act.
- During another song, a stage performer will use a single-use, handheld confetti blaster to launch confetti above the audience. We are prepared to handle post-show cleanup.
